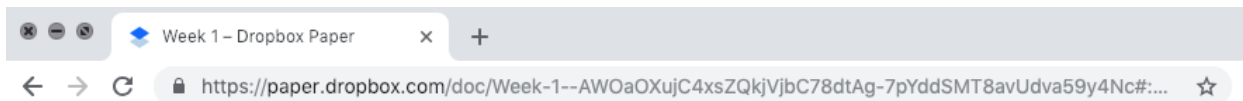


A **favicon** is the little icon that appears at the top of the browser window, to the left of the page title.

Favicons help “polish” off a website and are a fun way to extend the branding or concept to the site. All the websites you turn in for this class should have one.

Favicons are always 32 x 32 pixel png files (or .ico files, but more recently, png). Usually I’ll draw one in photoshop or illustrator. Try making one, and then save it as “favicon.png”

Link your favicon in the <head> element using the below syntax. (The “href” should lead to wherever you add it in your project.)

<link rel="icon" type="image/png" href="imgs/favicon.png">
```
